



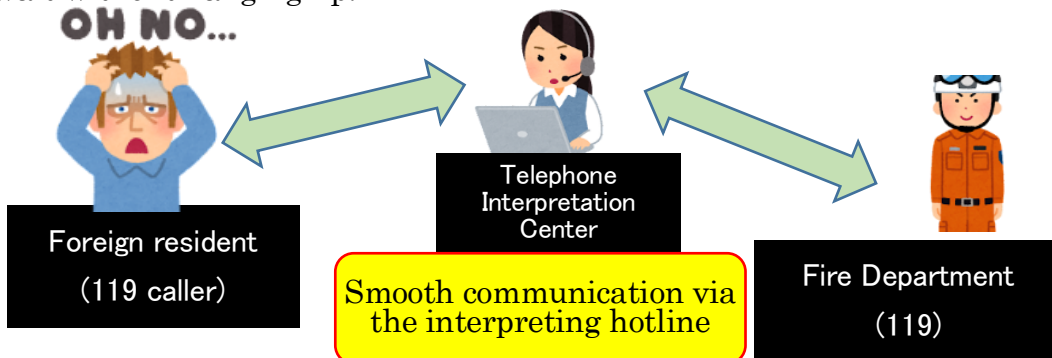

Simultaneous interpretation hotline and tablet available in many languages !
 The Iwamizawa Fire Department has introduced a simultaneous interpretation service and tablets to assist foreign residents during emergency calls and at emergency scenes.

① Response to 119 calls ~ Simultaneous interpretation ~

- ◆ Simultaneous three-way communication between the caller, the telephone interpretation center, and the fire department.
- ※ It will take a few seconds to connect to the telephone interpretation center, so please wait without hanging up.



② Ambulance response ~ Tablet or simultaneous interpretation ~

- ◆ Conversation using a tablet (multilingual translation app)
- ◆ Three-way simultaneous interpretation service via the Telephone Interpretation Center
- ➔ When communication via tablet is difficult or during an emergency situation with no ambulance present



③ Languages spoken

- ◆ Dial 119 or call an ambulance (Telephone Interpretation Center)

24-hour service (5 languages)	English, Chinese, Korean, Portuguese (including Brazilian Portuguese), Spanish.
10:00~18:00 (11 languages)	English, Chinese, Korean, Portuguese (including Brazilian Portuguese), Spanish, Thai, Vietnamese, Filipino (Tagalog), French, Russian, Nepali.

- ◆ Ambulance (tablet) ~ 31 languages
